# How to connect to ship's IT

## Connect your PC/notebook

- 1. Please make sure your Antivirus software is up to date before connecting to the ship's network.
- 2. Set your network adapter's IP settings to Automatic "DHCP".
- 3. Connect your device by ethernet cable or by Wifi to the ship's network.
- 4. The connection and assignment of an IP address will automatically be established.

### Access network shared folders (on xdc1)

The data storage server "xdc1" is available four you to store and exchange data during the cruise.

The network share is available here: \\xdc1.fs-heincke.local\home (User: fs-heincke\scientist, password by crew) It contains folders for Master, Crew and Scientists to save data to.

The storage is backed up once per day at 20:00 UTC.

#### Access network printers (on xdc1)

The server "xdc1" also provides network printers.

On \xdc1.fs-heincke.local (fs-heincke\scientist, password by crew) you will find a list of printers you can connect to.
